# SUMMER READING PROGRAM



**June 28 - August 15**

Join our Summer Reading Program open to infants through young adults. **Registration is ongoing for Plainview-Old Bethpage School District residents. Residents must sign up in person.** Proof of school district residency is required for each child registered. **Non-residents may register in person** for all reading programs except the "Incentive" starting Monday, July 12, space permitting.

**SEVEN EXCITING PROGRAMS ARE BEING OFFERED:**

**BORN TO READ INFANTS CLUB – INFANTS AND TODDLERS TO 17 MONTHS:**

Parents can read to their child and record the titles. If you have read twelve books to your child during the seven weeks of the program, your child will receive a certificate, gift, and an entry into a special raffle.

**BORN TO READ TODDLER CLUB – 18 MONTHS TO PRE-SCHOOL:**

Enrollees receive a packet of fun activities for parents and child to finish together. Complete the activity package and receive a certificate, prizes, and an entry into a special raffle.

**SUMMER READING DELUXE - PRE-SCHOOL THROUGH GRADE 4 (GRADE ENTERING IN FALL):**

This Summer Reading Program is a flexible, open enrollment "walk in" style program, lasting seven weeks. Members will be encouraged to come in weekly to report on a book of their choosing. A "listener" will guide them in their reports. As an incentive, a prize will be given each week a child presents a book report.

**SUMMER READING EXPRESS - PRE-SCHOOL THROUGH GRADE 4 (GRADE ENTERING IN FALL):**

Read books at home and complete our forms. After the third week, select a prize if you have read 3 books. If you read an additional 3 books by the end of the sixth week, you can select another prize. A bonus third prize may be selected if you read a total of 9 books by the end of the seventh week.

**INCENTIVE MIDDLE SCHOOL SUMMER READING PROGRAM - GRADE 5 – 8 (GRADE ENTERING IN FALL):**

**INCENTIVE YOUNG ADULT SUMMER READING PROGRAM - GRADE 9+ (GRADE ENTERING IN FALL):**

Earn library currency while having fun reading. School required reading will earn you extra dollars. Read your book, critique it at home, and bring the book review form into Family Center. Then go to the "library store" to select your prize.

**SLEEP AWAY CAMPERS - ALL GRADES:**

Bring our summer reading packet to camp & return with your book reports in exchange for great prizes.

**Program Guidelines & Registration Procedure**

- In order to register for a Family Center program, your child's date of birth **must** be on file in the Family Center. A birth certificate or passport will be required as proof of age. Registration for all programs is age specific.
- Preference is given to Plainview-Old Bethpage School District residents.
- POB Library Card numbers are required at the time of registration. If you register for someone other than your own child, you **must** have that person's card number as well.
- All programs begin on time. After 10 minutes, **NO ONE WILL BE ADMITTED.**
- \*SEE DATES AT A GLANCE for program registration dates.
- An accompanying adult **must remain in the Library** while the child is attending the program. For safety reasons, we cannot leave the program to escort a child to the restroom.
- **THE 3 STRIKE RULE:** Please call 938-0077 x237 to cancel if your child is unable to attend a Family Center program. Any family that fails to cancel two times will receive a warning. When this happens a third time, the family will be placed on a waiting list for any program they register for, for a 3-month period.
